<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Henry VIII was a Tudor king, who was famous for being married 6 times. Henry wanted a divorce, but the Pope said no, so Henry set up his own church (The church of England) Henry's actions caused much religious unrest and divisions within the church for many years to come. Elizabeth I was the last Tudor monarch and the daughter of Henry VIII Maps were originally made to represent human perception of the world and were not intended for navigation. Maps became more accurate over time as people learnt more about the world and got better at creating maps. Yate and Thornbury used to be market towns, surrounded by forests in medieval times. Flat maps, atlases, globes and digital maps can all be used to locate countries and describe features. Map symbols, compass points and co-ordinates all make maps easier to use.
