<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Children will learn about:</li> <li>The raids and invasions by Vikings in Anglo-Saxon Britain (Danegeld, King Etherlred II).</li> <li>Who the Vikings were and when they raised and settled.</li> <li>Significant events from the period and order these chronologically on a timeline.</li> <li>The Anglo Saxon kings who ruled during the Viking age and examine their influence and significance in British history (Alfred the Great and Athelstan, first king of England).</li> <li>The Anglo-Saxon justice system and compare and contrast crimes, punishments and laws with their modern day equivalents.</li> <li>Aspects of everyday Viking life (houses, clothes, food etc.).</li> <li>Edward the Confessor and how he shaped Britain.</li> </ul>	<p><b>Brave Change makers:</b></p> <p><b>Communication –</b> Listen attentively, question and respond to others. 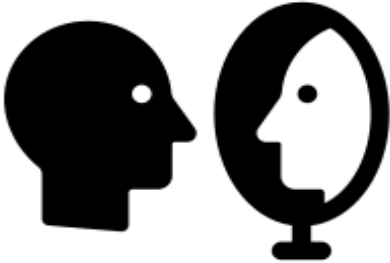

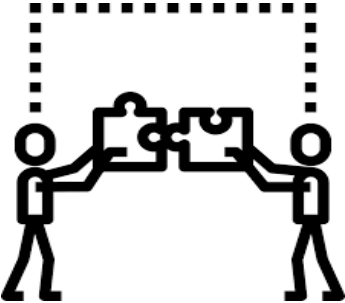

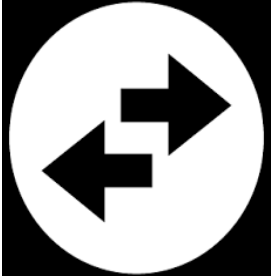
