Have fun reading and spelling on Phonics Hero! Phonics Hero will help you to read and spell each of the 44 sounds in the English language. The games build reading and spelling skills gradually, leading up to applying the skill independently. It's important to practise Phonics to recognise common letter-sound relationships, including sounds for common letter patterns so that you can apply them in decoding and spelling unfamiliar words. Can you help Zack save his superhero friends and ultimately defeat Dr. Lazy Bones?
