Brave Changemakers Outcome:



Term 3 mini product: Invite parents in for a poetry recital about oceans and seas.

Term 4 maxi outcome: Create a video to explain how we can be responsible citizens with our marine environment to share with our local MP.


Our Big Question:

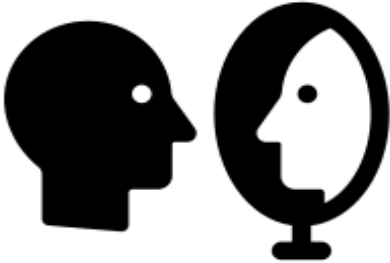

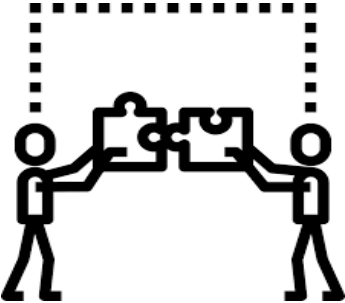

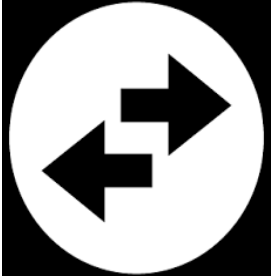
